Unit 5 Alternative Assessment Opportunity

Up to this point in our semester I have assessed your learning by tests at the end of each Unit that I have created based on the content of that Unit.

This unit you will have a say in the way you will be assessed. I will still formatively assess your learning from in-class quizzes, class work, and journal prompts, but the final summative assessment is now your choice from the following options.

You may choose from one of the following methods to complete on your own:

- (1) Unit test – continuing in the same format of assessment we have been using. I will provide you with a Unit test on the test deadline which you will complete in class after providing evidence of progress in your “hot seat.”
- (2) Interview (summary) – this will be a one-on-one style interview with me that will take about 10-15 minutes. I will ask questions for you to demonstrate knowledge of the unit terms and concepts. This will be a formal assessment, so you must approach all questions appropriately. You may use your personal notes that you have made to support your responses.
- (3) Create a test – now you have the opportunity to create a test that someone would take at the end of this unit to assess their learning. You must consider all sections of the unit, easy to difficult questions, test design, length and weight of questions. You will present the test to me and create the answer key “live” demonstrating the work you would see.
- (4) Project – this one is wide open! Create a project that accurately demonstrates all of your learning for this Unit. It is up to you how you go about doing this. Once you have a project idea touch base with me to ensure that it is sufficient. This will likely be the toughest out of the 4 options but for those of you that are creative it may be a lot of fun.

You must report what method of assessment you would like to have for this Unit by the beginning of next class!
